Education

At the center of Brightmont Academy's personalized learning approach is one-to-one instruction: one highly qualified teacher working with one student throughout every class. This enables instructional methods and scheduling to be individualized to best fit the student's needs. One-to-one instruction combines with a mastery-based learning approach, which allows the student to move ahead or receive additional instruction when needed so that they are always learning at their own pace. When students build skills and master content at 80% or higher, they advance to the next concept.

Admissions

Admission to Brightmont begins with a consultation with the Campus Director to learn about the individual learning needs of the student and determine program options that will allow the student to meet their goals. Applications are accepted year round and programs may start and end at any time.

Academic Success at Brightmont

93% of high school students are more confident about being successful after graduation.

81% of students who have struggled with focusing in school report that they focus better on their schoolwork since attending Brightmont.

Teacher Support at Brightmont

97% of students say their teachers make learning interesting for them.

97% of students say they are getting the academic support they need to be successful.

Well-Being at Brightmont

83% of full-time students are motivated to attend Brightmont compared to 12% at their previous school.

83% of full-time students are more confident at Brightmont than their previous school.

93% of full-time students who have studied at Brightmont for 1 year or more, and have struggled with anxiety, report having less anxiety at Brightmont than their previous schools.
